1 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to the calculation of local
2 property tax and the local option budget under the school finance
3 formula; amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 72-6433d and repealing the
4 existing section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 72-6433d is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 72-6433d. (a) (1) The provisions of this subsection shall apply in
9 any school year in which the amount of base state aid per pupil is \$4,433
10 or less.

11 (2) The board of any school district may adopt a local option budget
12 which does not exceed the local option budget calculated as if the base
13 state aid per pupil was \$4,433, or which does not exceed the local option
14 budget as calculated pursuant to K.S.A. 72-6433, and amendments thereto,
15 whichever is greater.

16 (b) The board of education of any school district may adopt a local
17 option budget which does not exceed the local option budget calculated as
18 if the district received state aid for special education and related services
19 equal to the amount of state aid for special education and related services
20 received in school year 2008-2009, or which does not exceed the local
21 option budget as calculated pursuant to K.S.A. 72-6433, and amendments
22 thereto, whichever is greater.

23 (c) The board of education of any school district may exercise the
24 authority granted under subsection (a) or (b) or both subsections (a) and
25 (b).

26 (d) To the extent that the provisions of K.S.A. 72-6433, and
27 amendments thereto, conflict with this section, this section shall control.

28 (e) The provisions of this section shall expire on June 30, ~~2014~~ 2019.

29 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 72-6433d is hereby repealed.

30 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
31 publication in the statute book.
