Subject: SB 39 –1st Kansas (Colored) Voluntary Infantry regiment mural

Senate Bill 39 would amend K.S.A. 75-2264 to authorize the capitol preservation committee to develop and approve plans to place a mural in the capitol honoring the 1st Kansas (Colored) Voluntary Infantry regiment.

SB 39 would authorize the secretary of administration to receive moneys from grants, gifts, contributions or bequests made to finance the creation and construction of the memorial. The memorial would not require any public funds for its creation or construction.

SB 39 would establish in the state treasury the 1st Kansas (Colored) Voluntary Infantry regiment fund. Expenditures from the fund would be for the purpose of creating and constructing the memorial.

SB 39 would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
