SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2650 by House Committee on Government Efficiency

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2650 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2650 would establish the Office of Information Technology Services, headed by the Executive Chief Information Technology Officer (ECITO), who would be appointed by the Governor. The bill would abolish the Division of Information Systems and Communications (DISC) and the Director of DISC. All responsibilities of DISC would be transferred to the Office of Information Technology Services.

The Department of Administration states that HB 2650 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
