Subject: HB 2687 – Concerning the State Building Advisory Commission; relating to reports and recommendations on state capital improvement budget estimates; amending K.S.A. 46-1702 and K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-3717b

HB 2687 would amend K.S.A. 46-1702 and K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-3717b to remove the requirement for the State Building Advisory Commission to report and make recommendations on each capital improvement budget estimate for capital improvement projects of state agencies.

The primary policy change is in Section 2 which amends K.S.A. 2011 Supp. 75-3717b to delete the requirements that the Commission prepare and report on recommended regarding capital improvement project costs, projected scheduling of funding for such costs, and such other matters as are deemed appropriate by the State Building Advisory Commission, to: (1) The Division of the Budget; (2) the Joint Committee on State Building Construction; and (3) the Legislative Research Department. The amendment in Section 1 makes a conforming amendment to K.S.A. 46-1702 to remove the requirement that the Joint Committee on State Building Construction study the reports. [History: L. 1978, ch. 337, § 11; L. 1987, ch. 196, § 10; Feb. 19.]

The act would take effect upon publication in the statute book.
