## Testimony before the Kansas House of Representatives Committee on Government Efficiencies on HB 2687

Mr. Chairman: It is a privilege and an honor to address the Committee on Government Efficiencies today regarding HB 2687. HB 2687 is the result of Governor Brownback's initiative to repeal outmoded, unreasonable, duplicative, onerous or unduly burdensome statutes and regulations. HB 2687 encompasses a statutory amendment that falls within the category of being onerous.

HB 2687 amends K.S.A. 46-1702's statutory language as follows:

(a) Study all five-year capital improvement and facilities plans and capital improvement budget estimates which are submitted to the joint committee by state agencies in accordance with K.S.A. 75-3717b, and amendments thereto and the reports on such budget estimates submitted to the joint committee by the state building advisory commission;

The Office of the Repealer urges favorable consideration of HB 2687.
