

**Testimony before the Kansas House of Representatives Committee on
Government Efficiencies on HB 2705**

Mr. Chairman: It is a privilege and an honor to address the Committee on Government Efficiencies today regarding HB 2705. HB 2705 is the result of Governor Brownback's initiative to repeal outmoded, unreasonable, duplicative, onerous or unduly burdensome statutes and regulations. HB 2705 encompasses a statutory amendment that falls within the category of being onerous.

HB 2705 amends statutory language as follows:
