**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2382 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2382 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2382 would allow counties that have adopted zoning regulations to adopt resolutions to abate nuisances within unincorporated areas of the county. The bill specifies what would be included in those resolutions.

The Kansas Association of Counties indicates enactment of HB 2382 would allow counties to charge abatement costs to the lot or parcel owner, which would allow counties to recoup expenses associated with abatements. However, if the full cost of abatements are not recovered, counties would absorb the unrecovered costs.
