
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 317 by Senator Faust-Goudeau

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 317 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 317 would allow an individual to submit a written request for restricted driving privileges when that individual's driving privileges have been revoked for driving with a canceled, suspended, or revoked license for failure to comply with a traffic citation. An individual would not qualify for restricted driving privileges if they had been convicted for driving with a canceled, suspended, or revoked license more than three times.

The Kansas Department of Revenue and the Kansas Judicial Branch state enactment of SB 317 would not have any fiscal effect on the operations of either agency. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 317 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
