1. Project Title: Rehabilitation and Repair		2. Project Priority: 1					
<p>3. Project Description and Justification:</p> <p>This continuing program is essential to the preservation, upkeep, and restoration of Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) buildings as they continue to age. It is intended to promote safe, energy efficient, serviceable, and functional facilities to support the mission of the agency and maximize protection of the original investment at a minimal cost.</p> <p>Individual locations and repair specifics vary from year to year depending on "wear and tear" and natural events. Any improvement projects or space alteration is based on a building/site condition analysis and an assessment of the impact on operating functions. Expenditures target repairs and equipment replacements for improved energy efficiency, emergency repairs, Americans with Disabilities Act enhancements, and other unanticipated utility-related occurrences at the building. In addition, this program includes repairs to the non-structural improvements to the land (i.e. sidewalks, parking lots, etc.)</p> <p>KDOT is responsible for the maintenance of approximately 972 buildings, totaling approximately 3.0 million square feet. Of those buildings, there are 200 primary buildings that house KDOT and KHP personnel, offices, shops, and labs. The remaining 772 structures support KDOT functions such as chemical, equipment and material storage facilities, as well as wash buildings. In addition to these buildings, there are 34 Safety Rest Area (SRA) buildings and five Motor Carrier Stations throughout the state that are maintained with these funds.</p>

<p>3. Project Description and Justification:</p> <p>This is a continuing program to replace deteriorating roofs on selected KDOT buildings. The requested projects represent priority needs based on on-site inspections. Complete reroofing is required when conditions are such that maintenance and repair treatments are no longer practical or feasible.</p> <p>The determination to reroof completely, rather than performing maintenance or repair action, is based upon several factors including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Age of roof; • Current condition of the roof; • Storm damage (hail, strong wind, etc.); • Previous maintenance; • Economics of repair versus replacement; and • Effects of leaks on building contents or usage <p>It is requested that plans and specifications for the roof replacement projects be prepared, contracts administered, and project inspection be done by the Department of Administration, Office of Facilities and Property Management (OFPM).</p>

1. Project Title: Subarea Modernization - Various Locations		2. Project Priority: 3	
<p>3. Project Description and Justification:</p> <p>This project continues a multi-year program to address the equipment bays of the KDOT subareas. Currently, the bays are not of sufficient depth to house agency dump trucks when they are equipped with a salt/sand spreader and a snowplow. This requires the dump trucks to be parked outside, not loaded with salt/sand material, and/or the snowplows to be unattached prior to a snow/ice event. Delayed response time is experienced due to cleaning the windshield of the snow/ice covered truck, loading it with salt/sand material, and attaching the snowplows before deployment to the highways. This extra time could be eliminated if the dump truck could be parked inside an adequately sized bay, which would allow it to be loaded and equipped before the storm.</p> <p>KDOT subarea facilities were constructed in the late 1950s and early 1960s. The current projections for these buildings are to use them for many more years. The subarea modernization program request addresses the equipment bay portion of these facilities. The agency will address subarea office needs using our rehabilitation and repair funds. In many cases, it is economical to replace the entire structure; this will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.</p> <p>It is requested that plans and specifications for this project be prepared, and the contract administered by OFPM. # Includes \$ 431,337 for OFPM fees.</p>

Kansas Department of Transportation Program Statement

The subarea work unit is the most important unit in KDOT. Over the years, due to changes in policies, technology, and equipment, the number of facilities and employees within each work unit has declined, thereby requiring each work unit to do more work with fewer resources.

Due to the reduction in resources, KDOT has been successful in continuing to meet the agency's mission by detecting and making improvements to inefficiencies in highway maintenance operations. Such improvements include, but are not limited to, new technologies and procedures and more expansive, sophisticated equipment.

Currently, the bays are not of sufficient depth to house the dump trucks when they are equipped with a salt/sand spreader and a snowplow. This requires the dump trucks to be parked outside and/or the snowplows to be unattached prior to a snow/ice event. Delayed response time is experienced due to the extra effort of cleaning the snow/ice covered truck and loading it with salt/sand material before deployment to the highways. This extra time would be eliminated if the dump truck could be equipped, loaded, and parked inside an adequately sized bay prior to impending inclement weather.

The KDOT Subarea facilities were originally constructed in the late 1950's and early 1960's; however, current projections require that the buildings remain in use for a considerable number of years. The subarea office requirements will be met by utilizing rehabilitation and repair funds.

The subarea modernization program consists of two to four subareas each year to meet current and future functionality. The number of subareas proposed each year is based on the bid costs for the fiscal year and the capacity of the KDOT Bureau of Maintenance project manager and the OFPM architects to manage the contracts. The modernization projects allow continuation of effective use of the existing facility for many more years to come. In many cases it is economical to replace the entire structure; however, this will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

It is anticipated that the enlarged subarea bays would improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the subarea crew and equipment to provide a quicker response to the highways during a snow/ice event.

1. Project Title: Update Electrical & Bay Extension Area Shops		2. Project Priority: 5				
<p>3. Project Description and Justification:</p> <p>This project is to consolidate the electrical systems from several different electrical panels located in different portions of the shop buildings. This project would also update the main service panels to 800-amp 3 Phase 208-volt service where necessary. This would replace the existing 400-amp service panels that do not meet current code requirements or needs. The main shops are currently 40 feet in depth. The depth of the shop does not allow some current equipment to fit in the shop and creates safety concerns when working on large pieces of equipment because the tight quarters force some work to be done outside.</p> <p>This project may also extend the existing bays 30 feet to the rear of the building with an approximately 30' x 120' addition. The addition to the end bay would have a 14' x 16' overhead door to make it a single drive-through bay. A three-ton, 100 foot long overhead single rail crane running across the addition would provide for lifting needs in the extended shop area. Alternatively, drive-through bays may be added to the rear or side of the building depending on the site configuration and needs.</p> <p>Proposed locations: FY 2025 Dodge City, FY 2026 Horton, FY 2027 Atwood, FY 2028 Marion, FY 2029 Phillipsburg, FY 2030 TBD</p> <p>An associate architect will be required for this project.</p>

1. Project Title: Surplus Property Warehouse - Topeka		2. Project Priority: 6	
<p>3. Project Description and Justification:</p> <p>This proposed facility would allow KDOT surplus property to be stored and organized prior to sale. The project would provide for the construction of a warehouse building to hold KDOT Headquarters and Materials and Research Center (MRC) surplus equipment; office building system equipment and parts; and oversized items that cannot be stored at KDOT's Headquarters at the Eisenhower State Office Building or at the MRC. The facility would have a footprint of approximately 14,900 square feet and would be built on the northwest corner of the new District One complex in Topeka. The facility would not have any permanent staff assigned to the building. However, it would have staff constantly working in it and members of the public would be on site to pick up surplus items and equipment that has been purchased through auction. The facility would be a single story, pre-engineered metal building with approximately 14,000 sq ft of warehouse capacity, 500 sq ft of office space, and 400 sq ft for bathrooms, crew room and file storage. This project is being proposed because the previously leased building located in Topeka has black mold and other safety issues such as falling chunks of ceiling. In the interim, KDOT has been able to secure leased space at the Forbes Field complex also in Topeka. However, KDOT seeks to create a permanent location for the disposal of surplus property and equipment.</p> <p>An associate architect would be requested for this project.</p> <p>* Includes fencing, drives, parking, and utilities.</p> <p># Includes \$ 27,286 for OFPM fees.</p>

Kansas Department of Transportation Program Statement

Current Facility:

The current facility is a one-story garage that was repurposed in 1986 as a lab and technical office for lab and construction technicians. The existing structure of 576 square feet is inadequate for the five technicians and materials lab. The lack of space is further complicated by several obsolete building systems including:

- Inadequate ventilation for a materials lab;
- The restroom is not ADA compliant;
- Inadequate electrical wiring and lighting;
- Obsolete and inefficient HVAC system;
- Mold from recurrent water intrusion; and
- No storage space for construction plans and drawings.

Renovating the existing building is not economically feasible. As a result, the existing building will be demolished upon completion of this project.

Proposed Facility:

The new facility would be constructed just north of the existing lab or to the east on open land at the Great Bend Area Four complex. The new building will allow all construction, lab, and Area crew staff to be housed in the same building along with associated equipment and storage space. It is anticipated the one-story building will have office dimensions of 35' by 100'. This would include approximately 1,000 square feet of office space - including an office for the RWIS technician, 600 square feet of cubical space, 600 square feet of lab and lab storage space, and 800 square feet for bathrooms, crew room, file, and storage rooms. The proposed facility would accommodate up to 10 KDOT employees including:

- 2 - Construction engineers
- 2 - Construction specialist and office coordinator
- 5 - Construction technicians
- 1 - RWIS technician

The project would relocate and consolidate to a single building the following facilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials and Research Center (10007) • District One Materials Lab (10025) <p>The building would be built on existing KDOT property near the I-70 interchange at 21st and Rice Road adjacent to the new District One site in Topeka. The proposed facility would house combined office, lab, conference room and storage space to support Research, the MTU, Soils, Geology, Pavement Management, Pavement Design, and a research library. An approximately 7,000 square foot vehicle storage building would be constructed as part of this project. Upon completion of this phase, the entire KDOT 21st and Van Buren complex could be vacated. Kansas Department of Transportation Program Statement

General:

The Materials and Research Center (MRC) is the main central laboratory for the entire State of Kansas. The Materials Test Unit (MTU), Pavement Management, Soils Lab, and the Bureau of Research are all housed at the MRC facility. The role of the central lab is to administer a testing and research program for prequalification, verification, and information for helping the construction and maintenance of the state highways in the entire State of Kansas. The work housed in the MRC is also responsible for dispute resolution between contractors and all Districts for the entire state. There are currently 75 full-time staff positions and 6 temporary summer positions housed at the MRC facility.

Current Facility:

The current MRC facility located in central Topeka was originally constructed in 1962-63 and is located near District One Headquarters to the south. The south steel building was constructed in 1990. Several projects have occurred over the years to maintain the facility (re-roofs, repairs, etc.). However, there are many aging or original core systems within the building which are antiquated and need extensive replacement and upgrades including plumbing, HVAC, and electrical. The complex consists of two structures: the main MRC facility and a south single level building that houses vehicles and equipment. The main MRC facility is approximately 60,000 square feet of combined office, lab and storage space housed on two levels in a heavily reinforced concrete structure design to support the needs of the testing equipment and materials. The main floor is approximately 38,400 square feet with office space on the main floor approximately 7,200 square feet and lab space approximately 31,200 square feet. The basement is approximately 21,600 square feet as it is only a partial basement as part of the main floor is slab on grade. The south building is a steel 7 bay 5,000 square feet heated structure used for maintenance and storage of vehicles and specialty equipment.

The current District One Materials Lab was constructed in 1936 and is located near the District One Headquarters. The lab is the last of the six districts not to be either replaced or renovated. The facility is very small and does not provide sufficient room to house the testing equipment to efficiently meet the current highway materials testing practices.

The MRC is one of the last KDOT structures that has not been replaced or renovated significantly. The facility was designed to be a central lab and due to the needs of the highway programs over the years, has fallen behind in efficiency, space, safety, and many other aspects of work that have changed significantly since the facility opened. Currently, many deficiencies have been noted throughout the building including major items such as: settling of the foundation, movement and shifting of walls on the main floor, and significant adjustments in the air quality depending on the season. In addition, other significant items include constant mold abatement needed in various parts of the building, constant service and repair of the boiler and cooling systems, and significant safety items throughout the facility that are due to outdated design and construction standards from when the facility was originally built.

Within the MRC facility, the main conference room is suitable for small meetings and training when needed but is limited by size. A second conference room is available but is regularly closed due to mold growth and air quality issues. A KDOT staffed stockroom is in the basement and is a needed asset for the facility due to the unique nature of the items that are stocked specifically for the testing performed in the facility. In addition to testing equipment space and computer server storage for LIMS and Pavement Management, a machine shop and large amounts of storage are held in the basement of the facility for items belonging to Research, the MTU, Soils, Geology, Pavement Management, Pavement Design, and other Divisions. A portion of the Research Library is also housed in the basement of the facility and is at risk due to mold growth in the area around the library.

Program Statement (continued)

Recent improvements and repairs include a new roof that was installed in the fall of 2020. This was a significant improvement over the existing tar roof to a newer HDPE roofing membrane which has been working well since installation. A major renovation and upgrade to one HVAC cooling system was done in 2016. HVAC in the front office was upgraded and redone in 2005 but is beginning to show signs of age as parts are becoming more difficult to obtain. Repairs such as replacing ceiling tiles, painting, installing new flooring and cove base were performed in 2013 in the front office and multiple offices throughout the lab. Bathrooms in the lab areas were remodeled in 2005. The current boiler was installed in the early 1990's after the original boiler failed and has had continuous repair and maintenance for the last decade with multiple times during the winter being down without heat in the building. Many of the core systems are either in need of replacement or are beginning to show signs of age with increased maintenance and repair needed.

Proposed Facility:

This project would relocate and consolidate to a single site the following facilities:

- a) Materials and Research Facility (10007)/District Materials Lab (10025)
- b) South Building Vehicle and Equipment Storage (10009)

It is proposed the complex would be built on existing KDOT property near the I-70 interchange at 21st and Rice Road in east Topeka.

The proposed facility would include a new building to house all current MRC Divisions. The proposed MRC would be approximately 50,000 square feet minimum and include multiple testing labs to house all existing equipment and potential future equipment. It should also include office space for existing employees, storage for existing materials and computer systems, bays for vehicles, and a machine shop to house existing equipment. In addition, space for a stockroom for lab supplies would be needed to house the special materials required for testing. Space would also provide for a 30+ person shared use training and conference room, an equipment supply storage, an employee break room, rest rooms, and multiple offices throughout the facility.

In addition, the new facility would require state of the art safety, air quality, and air handling systems. Due to the wide variety of materials tested, significant amounts of exhaust and air handling are needed. The proposed structure would accommodate new and existing testing equipment and future new testing procedures related to the use of highway materials quality control/quality assurance specification requirements, pavement management, and research.

It is anticipated the new MRC facility would improve efficiency of staff, equipment, and functionality for MRC personnel in addition to personnel from throughout the state when they use MRC services, equipment, or visit the MRC. The new facility could also provide an operational efficient building design by incorporating District 1 facilities and other District 1 needs if feasible. The new location would provide increased space for improved and efficient operations at a single site near the highways of KDOT's responsibility.

Kansas Department of Transportation Program Statement

Current Facility:

The current facility is a concrete block and brick building, built in 1982 consisting of approximately 4,700 square feet of vehicle storage and 2,300 square feet of office/lab space. Support buildings for the site consist of a salt/sand bunker, a salt storage cone, a wash building, brine making equipment and a 10-bay equipment storage building. The size of the yard restricts some maintenance activities and materials storage ability. Due to surrounding residential development, purchase of adjacent property is not feasible. Activity and noise, particularly during a late-night snow event, are also not welcome in a residential neighborhood.

The subarea is the basic unit of highway maintenance. It is responsible for the physical maintenance of all state highway roadsides, roadways, structures, and associated facilities located within its boundaries as follows:

Maintains Approximately:

310 lane miles of roadway
77 bridges
500 acres of right-of-way
2,000 signs
60,000 feet of guardrail

Present staffing plans:

1 - Subarea Supervisor
1 - Equipment Operator Specialist
12 - Equipment Operators

Regional Lab:

4 – Lab Technicians

Proposed Facility:

A new subarea shop that will house a subarea crew, vehicle storage for eight dump trucks and a regional materials lab is proposed. The building will have approximately 10,500 square feet of space. The space will be divided into 2,500 square feet of insulated, weatherproofed, heated, and cooled office, lab and storage area with 8,000 square feet of vehicle storage including an internal wash bay. The office shall include: 2 supervisor offices, a crew/safety meeting room, male and female restrooms, materials lab, and storage area. The building will be used as the headquarters for the subarea crew and the regional materials lab.

Uses for the building include material and parts storage and a garage for subarea crew and area crew trucks. The bays are sized to house tandem axle dump trucks equipped with snowplows and material spreaders. The configuration of the building will generally be left to the architect to decide based on the site parameters and budget limitations.

The project will include the construction of ancillary structures necessary for a combination of subarea-area crew facility. This includes a 10-bay equipment storage building, a chemical storage building, a salt/sand bunker, and fueling facilities.
