First 90 Days Plan

- Prepare
 - Learn organization function, culture and required skills
- Assess
 - Understand priorities
 - Evaluate current architecture and technology strategy
- Plan
 - Create charter to establish operating model
 - Update and share technology strategy



Judicial Branch 3-Year IT Plan

- 17 Action Items
 - Application Modernization
 - Cybersecurity
 - Process Improvement
 - Customer Experience Improvement
 - Statutory or Policy Compliance



Senate Bill 291 Actions Update

- IT Service Consolidation including CSF 2.0 Compliance
 - Draft plan is being developed
 - Identifying external resources to estimate cost and time
- Migration to .Gov Domain
 - 11 out of 16 websites completed
 - Migrating both email & websites
 - Estimate to complete all sites by Jan 22, 2025
- Tracking of Cybersecurity Spending
 - Starting FY25
 - Dedicated Cybersecurity Budget created



Senate Bill 291 Actions Update (Cont.)

- Cybersecurity Awareness Training
 - Implemented and in place for annual training
 - Created Judicial Branch Policy to enforce
- Judicial Branch CISO Contract Review
 - Standard Security Terms Developed
 - Apply to all IT contracts starting FY25
- CISA Audit
 - Joined CISA
 - Audit on Dec 11 –13, 2024
